The focus will be on a variety of skills to be successful and will include stretching, power, ice presentation, body control, landing positions, proper stroking alignment, and jumping fundamentals. MOVES IN THE FIELD SESSION

Although Moves in the Field is not new to the advanced skater, the session set aside just for this is new. It is believed and proven that if you skate just moves daily, you will pass these tests quickly!

CHANGES THIS YEAR

BASIC SKILLS MEMBERSHIPS now run consecutively with the USFS membership season of July 1 – June 30 of each year.

PAYMENTS will now all be paid up front! If you make payments, you will postdate your checks and they will be held until the due date when they will be cashed

MEMBERSHIP FORMS for private skaters will now be turned in with your registration form and must be paid before your skater is allowed to skate! Your skater will not be registered with USFS this year until this form has been turned in and paid!

MEMBERSHIP PACKETS will be given out at the Parent/Skater Meeting to be held June 16 at 7:00 pm when skating is done.

ICE WILL BE PURCHASED IN BLOCKS FIRST. You MAY THEN SUPPLEMENT WITH A PUNCH CARD.

BUY-ONS WILL BE PRE-PAID EITHER VIA A PUNCH CARD OR PAY THE DAY YOU SKATE IN FULL. ALL BUY-ONS WILL BE PURCHASED AS A WHOLE SESSION – NO PARTIAL BUY-ONS.

BASIC 1 – FREESKATE 2 - 1 HR FREESKATE SESSION IS CONSIDERED A WHOLE SESSION.

FREESKATE 3 & UP – MOVES AND FREESKATE ARE CONSIDERED A WHOLE SESSION

NO CHARGING OF BUY-ONS WILL BE ALLOWED! YOUR SKATER WILL BE WARNED ONLY ONCE, THEN THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SKATE UNTIL PAID.
