

Annual Ice Review
"Peace, Love, Skate"

April 9, 10, & 11, 2021

Registration dates: Now - February 1, 2021

The ANNUAL ICE REVIEW is the **highlight** of the skater's season! This year's theme will be "Peace, Love, Skate" which will include music from various musicians such as Bruno Mars, Sugarland, Katy Perry, and Glee! Due to the nature of the COVID pandemic, we will not be using traditional custom ordered costumes (which require purchase in late November). Skaters will instead have a more simple, in-stock costume for their number, which will be decided when we have final information about numbers in our show. Once registration closes and we have an official number of skaters, we will separate skaters into groups by level. <u>ALL</u> skaters, pre-K through 12th grade who skate during the fall and/or winter sessions, are welcome and encouraged to register for the show, INCLUDING those skaters who are learning to skate for hockey!

FEES/COST: There will be a \$50.00 non-refundable deposit <u>per skater</u> due at the time of registration. The rest of the payment will be due before picking up your costume in March. The fees include costume, all ice times, and coaching fees. Deposits are non-refundable. These fees <u>do not</u> include costume, ice time, or coach fees for **features or soloist**.

REQUIREMENTS: Register and pay the non-refundable deposit by **FEBRUARY 1st**. **NO LATE** registration will be allowed.

GROUPS: All skaters will be placed in their current skating level as of the sign-up date.

DISCOUNTS: 2nd Skater Discounts are available. If you have more than one skater in the show the skater at the lower skating level will receive 50% off their fee.

2nd NUMBER: Due to Covid-19 restrictions, we will not be offering a 2nd number option or a Father-Daughter option for skaters this year.

PICTURES: Pictures will be much different than in previous years due to Covid-19 restrictions. We will provide information about pictures and a picture date after registration closes.

VOLUNTEERS: Volunteers are needed to make the show happen!! Traditionally we require volunteers in the following areas; Merchandise, Flowers, Props, Lighting, Set Up, Take Down, Room Parents, and Ticket collection. This year, volunteering may look a bit different. Volunteer sign-up sheets will be available closer to the show so please keep an eye out for those and consider how you can help make the show a success!

SHOW PRACTICE: A show practice schedule will be given out closer to show time. Show practices will begin in March after the Winter Session has ended.
