Please read carefully as this contains all the information needed for participation in our show!

REHEARSAL SCHEDULE: The rehearsal schedule is attached. Our ice time is very limited this year due to the KXRA Show being held the 2nd weekend in April. **Group times are also based on which coach is in charge of each group and what conflicts THEY may have and/or days they are available.**

MISSED PRACTICES:

- *Skaters are expected to attend ALL practices! This does affect their practice if they miss.
- *Unexpected conflicts? You must CALL the assigned coach - find # by group assignment.
- *Too many missed practices? Your skater may not be able to participate.

COSTUMES & TIGHTS: Upon delivery, costumes should be tried on right away, pressed, hung, and marked with your skater’s name. A pick-up date the end of February will be announced. Skaters are required to have skating tights for the show. The club does have multiple sizes and styles available for purchase in the skating office.

PICTURES: Professional group and individual photos will be taken at Photo Magic of Alexandria on March 8 & 9. Specific picture times and order forms will be provided at costume pickup.

PAYMENTS: All balances due for the show must be paid when you pick up your costume.

ALL OTHER PAST DUE BALANCES will also be required at this time. If you need extra time to make a payment please make arrangements at this time. Thank you!

SKATES: Don’t forget to sharpen your skates, if necessary, at least two weeks before the show! Make sure you have cleaned and polished your skates!

RENTAL SKATES: IF YOU ARE RENTING SKATES, you are welcome to use them for the show. PLEASE PLAN TO DROP THEM OFF after the show on Sunday & get your deposit back.

GRAND FINALE PRACTICE: There WILL BE A Grand Finale Practice this year. See details under this day.

DRESS REHEARSAL: FRIDAY – APRIL 1, 6:00-8:30pm - EVERYONE MUST ATTEND!

- *ARRIVE at Arena at 5:45 pm sharp – go directly to assigned holding room – assignments posted.
- *Rehearsal will begin promptly at 6:00. Approximate rehearsal time 6:00 to 8:30 pm
- *Arrive in FULL COSTUME
- *WEAR warm coat & bring a blanket if you would like – skaters will watch rehearsal with assigned group and the adult that will be monitoring them.
- *NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED! Bottled water is fine.
- *Practice will take up to two hours – some groups may go through their number more than once.
- *You may arrive to PICKUP YOUR SKATER by 8:15. They may not be done until 8:30, however. If they are done early, we will allow them to go early.

SHOWS: SATURDAY – APRIL 2 at 6:30pm & SUNDAY – APRIL 3 at 2:00pm.

***ARRIVE at arena ½ hour before each show. No later!**

***Come in complete costume, makeup, and don't forget accessories!**

***Add a little blush, eye makeup, and lipstick.**

***SKATE GUARDS: HARD guards are required while in the rink to protect all those little fingers!**

***NO FOOD or DRINK ALLOWED. Bottled water is fine.**

***Skaters will be watching the show in the south end of the bleachers with their assigned room parent. Skaters ARE NOT ALLOWED to go with parents and sit with them during the show. They must stay with their assigned room monitors and sit in the south end of the bleachers only. We don't have time to look for them and we don't want to lose them. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated!**

VOLUNTEERS: Volunteers are greatly needed everywhere -- from room/group monitors to spot light operation & admission/tickets to flower/merchandise sales. We will be coordinating volunteers using SignUp Genius. A link will be provided at a later date. Thank you in advance for volunteering!!!

ROOM/GROUP MONITORS: Help is needed for BOTH shows and Friday night dress rehearsal to monitor each group of skaters. You get to watch the show for free the evening that you are helping. Again a SignUp Genius Link will be provided to sign up for this important job.

SHOW SHIRTS: Show shirts will be available for purchase. Order forms to come.

SHOW VIDEO: The show will be professionally recorded, edited and available for purchase. Order forms to come.

COVID-19: COVID-19/masking regulations in place at the time of the show will be followed. Further details will be provided closer to show time.

The majority of skaters will be ready to leave by 8:15-8:30. You may pick them up at this time. PLEASE feed them a hearty meal prior to rehearsal. NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED OTHER THAN WATER AT REHEARSAL! WEAR A COAT! Bring a blanket so they can watch while not on the ice in the stands. SKATE GUARDS ARE REQUIRED!
