The ANNUAL ICE REVIEW is the **highlight** of the skater's season! This year's theme, "With A Little Help From My Friends", will include songs from The Beatles – both covers and originals spanning from the 60's to now!

We are holding a separate registration for LTS skaters Basic 1-5 entering winter group lessons to participate

in one number. The cost of this LTS number is \$60.

If you missed registration and are in Snowplow Sam or a level beyond Basic 5, please reach out to Coach Tessa or Lisa for options. If we can make it work to add you to the show- we'd love to! (The cost for these numbers range from \$80-\$140 and participation is based on costume availability).

REGISTRATION & MEASUREMENTS: Registration is <u>completely online</u>. Please use the following link: <u>www.alexandriafigureskating.org/registration/</u>. Before registering, please have a coach or a board member measure your skater using the attached measurement sheet. You will use that sheet to enter sizes into GoMotion for costume ordering (Member tab > Sizing tab > enter values).

FEES/COST: As mentioned above, the fee for the LTS number is **\$60**. This includes a black club skirt that will be returned to the club after the last performance. The fees include: costume (except club skirt), all ice times, and coaching fees. Skating tights are required and available for purchase at the skating office for an additional cost.

REQUIREMENTS: To be eligible to skate in the show, skaters must skate the AFSC Fall session and/or the Winter session. This requirement is for both private and class skaters.

GROUPS: All skaters will be placed in their current skating level as of the sign-up date.

PICTURES: Pictures will be February 20th, 2024 at Photo Magic in Alexandria. Pictures for the programs will be in costume. When you receive your costume, it will include a "how to" for costume, hair, and make-up. These are very useful so your skater looks the best they can for pictures and the show. We will provide a picture taking schedule and order forms closer to the date.

VOLUNTEERS: Volunteers are needed to make the show happen!! We will require volunteers from each family to help in the following areas; Room Parents, Ticket Sales, Merchandise/Flowers/Chuck-a-Duck Sales, Spot Lights, Props, Set Up and Take Down. Please let us know what area you would like to volunteer your time for! A sign-up binder will be available closer to the show.

SHOW PRACTICE: A show practice schedule will be given out closer to show time. Practices traditionally start in March after the end of the Winter Session on our normal Sunday, Monday and Thursday skating nights. We will also have a dress rehearsal on Friday, April 5, 2024 in addition to the shows on April 6th & 7th. **Attendance is important and unexcused and/or multiple absences may cost you your place in the show**.
