

ANNUAL ICE REVIEW 2025

"Heroes and Villains"

Show Dates: April 5 & 6, 2025

Registration deadline: November 22nd, 2024

(Registration opens October 14, 2024)

The ANNUAL ICE REVIEW is the **highlight** of the skater's season! This year's theme, "Heroes and Villains", will include songs from your favorite movies to hit songs – which side of the spectrum will you favor?

<u>ALL</u> skaters, pre-K through 12th grade who skate during the fall and/or winter sessions, are welcome and encouraged to register for the show, INCLUDING those skaters who are learning to skate for hockey! We will be including a parent/skater "hero" number this year as well as a contrasting "villain" number available for all skaters to choose from. **The**November 22nd, 2024 registration deadline is firm.**

**We will be holding a separate registration in January for FIRST TIME skaters ONLY (LTS Basic 1-5) entering winter group lessons to participate in one number.

REGISTRATION & MEASUREMENTS: Before registering, please measure your skater using the attached measurement sheet. The club offers sizing leotards and assistance as needed. Please see a board member or coach with questions. You will use this sheet to enter sizes into GoMotion for costume ordering (Member tab > Sizing tab > enter values).

FEES/COST: There will be a **\$60.00-\$70.00 deposit per skater** due at the time of registration. Deposits are non-refundable. You may also pay in full at time of registration. Costume pick-up will happen as orders arrive, please keep an eye out for communications on GoMotion. The fees include: costume, all ice times, and coaching fees. Skating tights are required and available for purchase at the skating office for an additional cost. These fees <u>do not</u> include: costume, ice time, or coach fees for **features or soloist**.

REQUIREMENTS: To be eligible to skate in the show, skaters must skate the AFSC Fall session and/or the Winter session. This requirement is for both private and class skaters.

GROUPS: All skaters will be placed in their **current skating level** as of the sign-up date.

DISCOUNTS: 2nd Skater Discounts are available. If you have more than one skater in the show the skater at the <u>lower</u> skating level will receive 50% off their main group number fee. Skaters need to both be on the same payment plan in order to get the 50% off 2nd Skater Discount.

2nd NUMBER: We will be offering a 2nd costumed number for all levels, so your skater(s) will have the opportunity to skate in the show twice! The kids really enjoy this as family &

friends can see them on the ice more than once. The Learn to Skate (LTS) Basic 1-Basic 5 extra number will include a top and club skirt. The club skirt will be returned after the 2nd show.

OPTIONAL PARENT "HERO" NUMBER: If you have interest in the Parent & Skater "Holding Out For a Hero" -Bonnie Tyler number please sign up on your skater's form. The cost is only \$50 and \$20 per additional skater (sorry, only one parent per skater). Parents and Skaters will provide and wear their own costumes; parents will be required to wear a costume based on an occupational hero, ie- military, nurse, doctor, utility workers, police, firefighter, etc. Skaters will wear a dress of choice. No skating experience required! Your skaters would love to skate with you!

OPTIONAL "VILLAIN" NUMBER: If your skater would prefer to do the "Look What You Made Me Do" -Taylor Swift villain number over the parent/skater hero number, the cost is also \$50. Skaters will provide their own black leggings; shirts will be provided for the skaters.

PICTURES: Pictures will be **Wednesday, February 19th, 2025 at Photo Magic in Alexandria**. Pictures for the programs will be in costume. When you receive your costume, it will include a "how to" for costume, hair, and make-up. These are very useful so your skater looks the best they can for pictures and the show. We will provide a picture taking schedule and order forms closer to the date. If you cannot attend picture night please make sure you let us know.

VOLUNTEERS: WANT TO GET INTO THE SHOW FOR FREE??? Volunteers are needed to make the show happen AND YOU DON'T HAVE TO PAY ADMISSION FOR THE SHOW YOU WORK, YEA! We will require volunteers from each family to help in the following areas; Room Parents, Ticket Sales, Merchandise/Flowers/Chuck-a-Duck Sales, Spot Lights, Props, Set Up and Take Down. Please let us know what area you would like to volunteer your time for! A sign-up will be available closer to the show.

SHOW PRACTICE: A show practice schedule will be given out closer to show time. Practices traditionally start in March after the end of the Winter Session on our normal Sunday, Monday and Thursday skating nights. We will also have a dress rehearsal on Friday, April 4, 2025 in addition to the shows on April 5th & 6th. Attendance is important and unexcused and/or multiple absences may cost you your place in the show. NO REFUNDS.

The show will be an on-going work in progress all year. Check website and GoMotion for updates and alerts.
