Show Dates: March 28 & 29th, 2026

## Registration deadline: November 11th, 2025

(Registration opens around October 27, 2025)

#### WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

All skaters, **Pre-K through 12th grade**, who skate during the AFSC fall session and/or winter sessions are welcome and encouraged to register — **including Learn to Skate participants who skate for hockey!** 

#### **REGISTRATION DEADLINE**

November 11, 2025 (This deadline is firm.)

A separate registration will open in January for **first-time skaters only** (LTS Snowplow Sam–Basic 4) entering winter group lessons, who will participate in one number.

#### **REGISTRATION & MEASUREMENTS**

Before registering, please measure your skater using the attached measurement sheet. The club offers sizing leotards and assistance as needed. Please see a board member or coach with questions. You will use this sheet to enter sizes into GoMotion for costume ordering (Member tab > Sizing tab > enter values).

#### FEES/COST

There will be a \$75.00 deposit <u>per skater</u> due at the time of registration. Deposits are non-refundable. You may also pay in full at time of registration. Costume pick-up will happen as orders arrive, please keep an eye out for communications on GoMotion. The fees include: costume, all ice times, and coaching fees. Skating tights are required and available for purchase at the skating office for an additional cost. These fees <u>do not</u> include: costume, ice time, or coach fees for **features or soloist**.

#### **DISCOUNTS**

First-time skater discounts and second & third skater discounts are available! If you have more than one skater in the show, the skater at the **lower skating level** will receive **50% off their main group number fee.** Skaters must both be on the **same payment plan** in order to receive the 50% off second skater discount.

#### **SECOND NUMBER**

We will be offering a 2<sup>nd</sup> costumed number for all levels, so your skater(s) will have the opportunity to skate in the show twice! The kids really enjoy this as family & friends can see them on the ice more than once.

#### **PICTURES**

Pictures will be **Wednesday, February 11th, 2026 at Photo Magic in Alexandria**. Pictures for the programs will be in costume. When you receive your costume, it will include a "how to" for costume, hair, and make-up. These are very useful so your skater looks the best they can for pictures and the show. We will provide a picture taking schedule and order forms closer to the date. **If you cannot attend picture night please make sure to let us know.** 

#### **VOLUNTEERS**

Volunteers are needed to make the show happen — and you don't have to pay admission for the show you work! We require volunteers from each family to help in the following areas: Room Parents, Ticket Sales, Merchandise/Flowers/Chuck-a-Duck Sales, Spotlights, Props, Set-Up, and Take-Down. A sign-up will be available closer to the show.

#### **SHOW PRACTICE & DATES**

A show practice schedule will be given out closer to show time. Practices traditionally start in late February or early March after the end of the Winter Session on our normal Sunday, Monday, and Thursday skating nights. We will also have a dress rehearsal on Friday, March 27, 2026, in addition to the shows on March 28th & 29th. Attendance is important, and unexcused and/or multiple absences may cost you your place in the show. NO REFUNDS.
